

The Idaho Urological Institute (IUI), located about a mile from ICOM's campus, has a volunteer opening for 1 or 2 OMS-I from ICOM to participate in their clinical trials research. If you are interested in urology or in clinical trials, you will get an excellent introduction to the language and clinical research and this specialty.

Duties: The ICOM student will be searching the electronic health record for patient eligibility or pulling data of interest for third-party sponsored trials (mostly drug but some device). The trials are mainly for prostate and bladder cancer but also include overactive bladder and kidney stones and new trials are always starting.

Specific skills: attention to detail.

Duration: This position(s) is expected to begin by mid-March 2022 and continue through the summer and fall until March/April of 2023 when it will transition to a student(s) from the class of 2026. You are expected to be available 4-8 hours a week, with exceptions for finals week or other personal challenges that may arise.
